Dear Agency Director:

The Chicago Public Schools (CPS) is anticipating funds during the next legislative session to continue our early childhood initiatives. In preparation for the program year, we are asking agencies to apply for funding with the understanding that final approval will depend on state allocations. The Office of Early Childhood Education (OECE) is seeking to subcontract with community agencies wishing to provide services to preschool children.
